Eligibility:-

A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Welsh Area entry, in each class in the schedule. To qualify, riders need to comply with the above eligibility and need to wear an **arm band** when they compete, in order that they can be identified by the Steward.

Each winning Welsh Area Member exhibit from the classes will be asked to compete for the overall Welsh Area Championship at the end of the day.

QUALIFICATION B.S.P.S. 169/19

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S.) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S, are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S when making entries.

2019 B.S.P.S. SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS

This show is a qualifier for the 2019 B.S.P.S. Championships Show to be held at Arena UK. Qualification rules will be subject to the rules of the 2019 Championships Show. The 1st and 2nd prize winners in the following classes will qualify: Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Open 128cms, 138cms, and 148cms. Show Ponies. The 1st and 2nd prize winners in Open Nursery Stakes, Open 133cms, 143cms, 153cms. W.H.P., Open 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms. S.H.P. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Open Cradle Stakes, Open Intermediate Classes.

In mixed height classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify, provided the animal is registered and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member in accordance with Rules 21 and 26.

The BSPS "CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP (UK) LTD." CHALLENGE.

All shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S. are qualifiers for **The BSPS "CLASSIC SECURITY (UK) LTD." CHALLENGE**

The "BSPS Challenge" ponies qualify as follows: Leading Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Ponies, Open Show Hunter Ponies, Open Intermediate SH. SRT and WH, and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

The highest placed pony within the top five that has not qualified for the 2019 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify.

If after qualifying for the BSPS "CLASSIC SECURITY (UK) LTD" CHALLENGE a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the **"The BSPS "CLASSIC SECURITY (UK) LTD." CHALLENGE.**

HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the appropriate classes will qualify for the HERITAGE CHAMPIONSHIP at the B.S.P.S. Championship Show. Owners and riders MUST be either B.S.P.S. members or B.S.P.S. Heritage Members to enter. Ponies should be registered in the Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, Highland, Fell, Dale, Connemara and Welsh C & D.

THE B.S.P.S. PREMIER LEAGUE

This show is a qualifier for the "B.S.P.S. Premier League." The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies in the Open Classes that are not qualifiers for Horse of the Year Show - Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128cms, 133cms., 148cms. Show Pony, Lead Rein Hunter Type; 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms. Show Hunter Pony and Cradle and Nursery Stakes; 133cms, 143cms, and 153cms. Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter and Working Hunter Classes.

B.S.P.S. "BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" RIDER OF THE YEAR

The best rider in each of the following Open Classes will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championship Show – Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Open 128cms., 138cms and 148cms. Show Pony, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, Open 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms. S.H.P., Open Cradle and Open Nursery Stakes, Open 133cms, 143cms and 153cms. W.H.P. Intermediate S.R.T., S.H. & W.H. classes, Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden Classes, and to riders who have not attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year in the Heritage Ridden and W.H.P classes.

The 1st and 2nd, placed pony will qualify in the following classes: Open Leading Rein and First Ridden, Open 128cm,
138cms and 148cms Show Pony classes, Open 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Show Hunter Pony classes, Open 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, Intermediate WH, Inter SRT and SH Classes.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW 2019

This show is a qualifier for the Horse of the Year Show 2019, NEC Birmingham, Wednesday 2nd – Sunday 6th October 2019. The highest placed pony, not already qualified, from the first five ponies will qualify in the following classes: The Price Family Lead Rein pony, The Price Family First Ridden pony, The British Show Pony Society Children's Riding Pony 128cm., 138cm. and 148cm; National Pony Society / Snuggly Hoods Working Hunter Pony 133cm., 143cm. 153cm and Intermediate.

THE HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW QUALIFICATION IS SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION FROM THE HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW OFFICE.

Owners and riders must be BSPS, NPS, The Showing Register or Ponies (UK) Members and the pony registered with either BSPS, NPS, The Showing Register or Ponies (UK) and a copy of a valid height certificate lodged with that society to compete in classes with qualification for Horse of the Year Show. Evidence of membership and pony registration, must be completed on the Horse of the Year Show entry form.

The BSPS LeMieux Heritage Mountain & Moorland Ridden Classes

Ponies' owners & riders must be BSPS members before the date of the show to compete in the Olympia classes. Classes will be judged under BSPS rules as per the 2019 BSPS rule and show hand book. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards.

The 1st and 2nd prize winners from each of the following classes will qualify for a semi-final to be held at the BSPS Heritage Championship Show at Arena UK 2019. (The qualification will NOT be passed down the line). These classes are also qualifiers for the BSPS 'Classic Security' UK Ltd Challenge, the BSPS Premier League 1st-4th to qualify, the BSPS 'Black Country Saddles', Best Rider.

All ponies must be 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

The highest placed 2 ridden ponies will qualify for the "BRYNSEION Ridden championship to be held at Three Counties showground on tbc.

The Champion will qualify for Olympia, The London International Horse Show. The first placed animals, excluding the Champion Pony, in classes 11-16 will qualify for the LeMieux BSPS Championship semi final at Arena UK, Grantham on the 13th and 14th October 2019.

RULES

1. The Judges named in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge; the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge who is unable to attend.
2. No nomination or substitute entries are allowed and no entry fee will be refunded.
3. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to the property of competitors, onlookers, servants, ponies, in connection with or arising from this show.
4. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
5. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entries or entry to the Show. BSPS Wales offer a strictly no refund policy.
6. Entry numbers will be collected at the show.
7. Competitors competing at any show which is run under the B.S.P.S rules must at all times when mounted be wearing a correctly secured British Standard skull cap/riding hat No's; PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 accredited. See Rule 46 of the B.S.P.S rule book (2019).
