This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in BSPS Classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the 2020 BSPS Rule & Show Handbook.

Owners and Riders must be BSPS Members and the Pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with RIHS Qualification.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to present themselves at the ring on time.

Correctly Secured Riding Hats must be worn by all riders whilst mounted. All PAS015, VGI, ASTM F1163 04A Onwards, Snell E2001, All AS/NZS 3838 2003 Onwards.

Training Stakes – Open to Members and Non-Members

Class 1 The BSPS Training Stakes

Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF FENCES 60cms.

Class 2 The BSPS Training Stakes

Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. MAXIMUM HEIGHT OF FENCES 80cms.

Animals may be entered in more than one class in this section.

Method of Judging - Animals will be required to jump a course of fences, they will be immediately asked to give a short show including a change of rein and gallop in the same ring.

Marks – Jumping 60 points, Style and Manners while jumping 20 points, Show mark and Manners 20 points. Total 100 points

Class 3 Unaffiliated Leading Rein WHP. Open to Plaited and Heritage. Ponies not exceeding 122 cm. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (This is not a qualifying class).

Class 4. Unaffiliated Nursery Stakes. Ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (This is not a qualifying class). Open to Plaited and Heritage.

Mini WHP Championship 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 3-4

Class 5 MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 158cms (15.2 hh). Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride, Riders must declare which section they are competing in. Riders may ride more than one animal, providing the animals are of a different height section. Intermediate horses will jump first.

Class 6 MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE HERITAGE WORKING HUNTER PONY
Ponies 4yrs old and over riders any age. Riders may ride more than one animal, providing the animals are of a different height.

NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st and 2nd Prizewinners on Classes 5 and 6

Class 7 MIXED HEIGHT OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 158cms (15.2 hh). Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride, Riders must declare which section they are competing in. Riders may ride more than one animal, providing the animals are of a different height section. Intermediate horses will jump first. Restricted competitors to wear an armband.

Class 8 MIXED HEIGHT HERITAGE OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY
Ponies 4yrs old and over riders any age. Riders may ride more than one animal, providing the animals are of a different height.

Class 9 WORKING HUNTER
Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over exceeding 153cm

Working Hunter Championship for 1st and 2nd Prize Winners in Classes 7 - 9

Classes 7 and 8, 1st prize winners will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions

COMPETITORS MUST DECLARE AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE RING BY 12.45 PM TO COMPLETE IN CLASS 10 AND THEREAFTER MUST DECLARE BEFORE THE START OF THEIR CLASS.

CLASS 10. The BSPS (RIHS) NURSERY STAKES Mare or Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 11. The BSPS (RIHS) WHP Mare or Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 12. The BSPS (RIHS) WHP Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms, suitable for and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 13. The BSPS (RIHS) WHP Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms, suitable for and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 14. The BSPS (RIHS) INTERMEDIATE WH Mare or Gelding 4 years or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms, suitable for and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 10, 1st prize winners will qualify for the BSPS White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

Class 11 - 14, 1st prize winners will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions.

1. This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society, and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in these classes whether or not members are subject to the constitution and rules of this society including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of this society.
2. All B.S.P.S. Classes will be judged under the rules in the 2020 B.S.P.S. Rule and Show Handbook.
3. The judge's decision is final.
4. The judges named in this schedule have accepted the invitation to judge but the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge who is unable to attend.
5. No nomination or substitution entries are allowed.
6. No spurs may be worn in B.S.P.S. Classes.
7. Objections should be made in writing with the objector's full name and address, within an hour of the event-taking place, and lodged at the secretary's office with the sum of £10 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained. Any objection in respect of a J.M.B. Certificate will be dealt with in accordance with J.M.B. Rules.
8. The committee shall not, in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the showground or onto any premises in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same.
9. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their assistants or riders and for the conduct of such assistants and riders and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the instructions given by the judges or stewards. No juvenile, mounted or un-mounted will be allowed in collecting ring without adult supervision.
10. This Show is a qualifier for the RIHS. Only one pony in each of the Nursery Stakes or OpenWHP or Anglo and part bred Arab or Lead Rein Hunter Type or Open SHP classes or Lead Rein Class or First Ridden Class or Open Intermediate SR, SH, and WH or mixed height Pretty Polly Show Pony, Pretty Polly SHP, Pretty Polly Intermediate SRT/SH. 133 -153 cms SHP, Pretty Polly Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Heritage Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden Classes qualifiers and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in each class will qualify. In the Pretty Polly Heritage Open Ridden Mixed Breeds, the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in the class will qualify. Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. Members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with R.I.H.S. qualification.
11. 1st and 2nd place in classes 10 - 13, 1st - 3rd in class 14 and 1st - 4th in classes 7 will qualify for the BSPPS Summer Champs. Animals must be registered under Rules 21 & Rules 26.
12. This show is a qualifier for the Blue Riband Championships to be held at the B.S.P.S. Championship Show. Ponies must be owned registered and ridden by a B.S.P.S. Member to compete in these classes.
13. In the Intermediate classes riders over 18 years and including 25 years must be showing members.
14. This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Challenge, The highest placed pony in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Intermediates & Heritage classes. Animals must qualify for the challenge by attending any B.S.P.S affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for 2020 Horse of The Year Show in the appropriate class. BSPPS Rule 516.
15. All Pretty Polly Classes will be run under B.S.P.S. Pretty Polly rules as laid out in the 2020 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook.
16. Royal International Horse Show. – The R.I.H.S. levy is £10.00 per entry. Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. Members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with qualification for the R.I.H.S.
17. B.S.P.S. Premier League – This Show is a qualifier for the Premier League, ponies will qualify by competing in the open classes. Black Country Saddles rider of the Year – The Best Rider in each of the following Open classes at all BSPPS Affiliated Shows will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championships Show: - Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, 122, 133, 143, & 153 SHP, Intermediate SRT, SH & Heritage classes.
19. Owners and riders must be BSPPS Members to qualify in the RIHS Anglo & Part-bred Arab Classes. Animals must be registered with the AHS – BSPPS Rule 522.
